# Raindrops

## Hard Water Rinse Additive

A high quality rinse additive/drying agent formulated for use in high or low temperature commercial dishwashing machines. **Raindrops** is specifically formulated for use in hard water areas. Effectively counteracts calcium, iron and other hardness ions to assure sparkling clean results. Also helps to reduce scale levels in dishmachine. Eliminates the need for towel drying (a health code violation in most areas) which is time consuming, costly and contributes to dish breakage. Contains special foam control additives.

### Directions for Use

This product is designed to be dispensed with equipment installed and/or approved by your Service Representative. **Raindrops** should be injected into the final rinse water of the dishmachine at a concentration of 50 to 100 ppm, depending on operating conditions. The amount required and the rinsing and drying performance will be affected by water hardness, rinse water temperatures and the dish machine's mechanical action. Your Service Representative will review these factors and make adjustments as needed to produce good results.

**Note:** For proper sanitizing and drying, the final rinse water temperature must be maintained between 180° and 195°F.

### Safety Reminder

Prior to using this or any cleaning product, make sure employees read and understand the hazard information found on the product label and Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS). The label and MSDS will also provide information on handling precautions, protective equipment and first aid instructions which might be appropriate for this product.
