UltraChlor™

High Performance Laundry Destainer

UltraChlor is a powerful chlorine additive for removing stains from white and colorfast cottons, linens, and other fabrics. Whitens and brightens laundry in institutional and industrial applications. Rapidly penetrates and removes a variety of organic and inorganic soils. Not recommended for home use. This product should never be used on silks, wool, mohair, leather, spandex (lycra), or non-colorfast fabrics.

Directions for Use

Before using this product, assure that material is colorfast by testing in an inconspicuous area. This product is designed for automatic dispensing through equipment installed and/or approved by your Service Representative. The Representative will review soil levels, water conditions, load size and other factors in determining the amount of this product to be used. Generally, to whiten and brighten colorfast cotton, linen, nylon, dacron, orlon, and rayon, use ¼ to ½ cup of **UltraChlor** per wash load in top loading machines, or ¼ cup in front loading machines. Add to presoak, wash water or first rinse. Do not pour directly onto fabric. For removal of stubborn stains (grass, coffee, fruit, berry, etc.), mix 1-2 ounces to one quart of warm water in a glass container (not plastic). Immerse fabric for 5-10 minutes. Rinse completely. Repeat if necessary. Wash as usual.

Note: A 200 ppm solution of this product may be obtained by using approximately 2.2 oz. per 10 gallons of water.

Note: Like all chlorine products, **UltraChlor** degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

Prior to using this or any cleaning product, make sure employees read and understand the hazard information found on the product label and Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS). The label and MSDS will also provide information on handling precautions, protective equipment and first aid instructions which might be appropriate for this product.
