Directions for Use

Automatic Injection - the amount of this product to be used will vary according to the load size, soil type and amount, water conditions, and other factors. Your Service Representative will analyze these variables and set up dispensing equipment and usage concentration accordingly. In general, use 2 to 4 ounces of this product per 50 lbs. of load size where normal soil levels and water conditions are present.

When laundering delicate fabrics such as wool or silk, follow the manufacturer's label instructions.

Pre-Spotting - apply this product at full strength to stain before washing. Agitate with a soft brush. Allow detergent several minutes to penetrate soils, then wash as usual.

Presoaking - to prepare a presoak solution, dilute 1-2 ounces of this product per gallon of warm water. Soak for 15 minutes or longer, overnight if possible. Wash as usual.
